

It's also what brought us Chernobyl, telemarketing, and the Great Bathroom Flood of 2013.



Boys need parents. But the secret truth is that parents need boys. It would be awfully boring without them, wouldn't it?


Still, it might be nice to go one full week without having to call a plumber.

## Because that's not what you meant by "Clean it inside and out."






Dad will love this!

To referee their cage-match pillow fights.





Because if it weren't for you, he wouldn't even be wearing underpants.





To explain the difference between windows and doors.











Because every boy needs a mummy (or daddy).

Mom says it's good to share.





Because even the SWAT team needs backup.










To teach them where the food's supposed to go.






Because it might be hot, and he may be a dog, but you still cannot eat him.



To water them daily, so they'll grow.



I've got to try this indoors.




Because sand feels better between your toes than up your nostrils.




To teach them the art of accessorizing.
